

Recommended Planting Guide

 We advise filling around 30% of the total volume of your planter with either broken crockery or our Light Weight Expanded Hydro-Clay Pebbles to improve drainage and aeration of the roots.

2. We recommend using a soil-based potting compost when planting your plant.

3. Unless you have purchased a planter that we have reinforced to be able to move it whilst full, we recommend not moving the planter once planted up as the combined weight of the soil and the plant may damage the planter.

With the FibreSTONE range we also recommend adding a set of optional Feet to raise the planter up off the ground. This adds extra Frost protection & also aids drainage.

Our Wooden & Corten/Patina Planters already include feet in the construction of our planters.

Our FibreGLASS planters do not need feet and are designed to sit on flat level solid ground. These can not be raised of feet or be placed on uneven ground unless we are instructed to add reinforcement to the base of the planter. This is at additional cost.
