



Indoor Planting Guide

PLANTING STEPS

Step 1: Unpack your planter ready for planting.

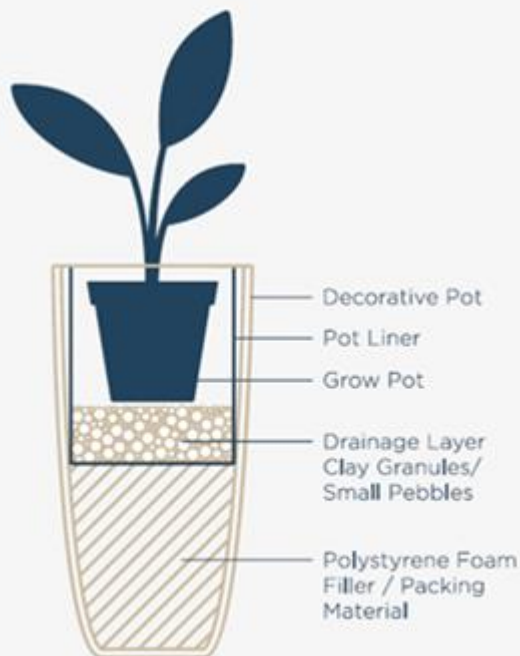
Step 2: Fill bottom of planter with polystyrene or packing material to desired height if required.

Step 3: Due to Fibrestone being porous, if water sits in the planter over a period of time water will be absorbed and can result in hairline cracks or slight leaks etc... We recommend placing a liner into the planter to ensure there are no leaks. This can be a soft plastic polythene liner, hard plastic liner (Cheap pot or an old Tupperware container) or simply a saucer for smaller planters. If these steps are followed the warranty remains valid with the manufacturer.

Step 4: It is good practise to add a drainage layer which will prevent root rot and also aid aeration of the roots. This could be some old broken crockery or better yet some Hydro-Clay pebbles that can be purchased on the website.

Step 5: Place your plant inside the planter with or without a Grow-sleeve / Grow pot. If not using a sleeve or grow pot we recommend using potting soil.

Step 6: Give your plant a good watering for the first time and away you go!!
